## Preaching Through The Bible Michael Eaton Genesis Delayed Glory (3: 21–24)

Two things happen through Adam's believing in the promise of Genesis 3:15.

## 1. Clothing 1. First, Adam and Eve receive clothing from God. 'And Yahweh God made garments of skin for Adam and for his wife. from God <sup>m1</sup> Genesis 3:7, and he clothed them'. In the garden of Eden, nakedness 21 Shame <sup>2</sup> see Genesis expressed innocence. Consciousness of nakedness expressed shame. $^{\mathbf{m}^1}$ From now on it is shameful to be naked in public. $^{\mathbf{m}^2}$ 9:22.23 · Garments of God's provision of clothes is a way of expressing the fact that <sup>1</sup> 2 Corinthians salvation when we believe, He clothes us with garments of salvation. We 5:21 are covered with righteousness; the Christian can say he has the Mark 9:3 righteousness of Jesus.<sup>11</sup> He has bright clothing; he is full of Revelation joy. He has clean clothing because he himself is clean in God. <sup>112</sup> 3:4 <sup>m3</sup> He soon will be clothed with the clothing of a glorious <sup>4</sup> 2 Corinthians resurrection body.<sup><sup>□</sup><sup>4</sup></sup> 5:1-2 • Death of a We note that the clothing required the death of a substitute. By substitute the death of a sacrifice clothing came from that sacrifice. By the death of God's Son we come to be clothed with the righteousness of God's Son. 2. However there is a second aspect to the matter. Adam and 2. Incomplete salvation Eve's salvation is not complete. They do not get to final glory. One day we shall be 'raised' with 'an imperishable body', 'raised and a contribution of the state of the stat in glory ... raised in power ... raised a body for the Spirit' <sup>11</sup> but 15:42-44 Adam had not reached that level of glory. Not vet Adam and Eve were not released from the fact that they would released from die. When we receive salvation it is a salvation in our relationship <sup>1</sup> Romans death to God, but we are still 'waiting for... the redemption of our body'. 8:23 <sup>1</sup> Adam was brought into **that** position. So he had to be put out of the garden of Eden. He could enjoy a relationship with God, but he could not yet enjoy resurrection-glory. The physical sign of God's anger towards sin remains for the moment. • Knowledge of Man had come to a knowledge of good and evil. He had known a good and evil taste of good (because he was once sinless); he had a taste of evil (because he was now a sinner). Now God speaks again. 'And Yahweh God said, "Behold the man has become like one of and 3:22 us in knowing good and evil. And now lest he stretch out his **m²** 3:23 hand and also take fruit from the tree of life and so eat it and live for ever... "<sup>1</sup>, and Yahweh God put him out of the garden of Eden to work the ground from which he had been taken<sup> $\mathfrak{m}^2$ </sup>. Humankind could have lived forever, not because they were naturally immortal but by eating of the tree of life. Now they are Eternal life in excluded. Man loses eternal life in fellowship with God. He had fellowship with that originally. He was in fellowship with God, and God and man God met with each other in the cool of the day. Life in fellowship with God was due to go on forever. That is what 'eternal life' is. It is life that goes on forever, but it is also a special kind of life. It is

life in closeness with God. Adam had known that life and should

have lived forever without death.

But now as a result of his sin he loses that. He is put out of access to the tree of life.

'And He thrust the man out, and at the east of the garden of Eden He placed the cherubim and the flaming sword which turned in every direction to quard the way to the tree of life'. <sup>@1</sup>

God was reconciled to Adam, but it was still necessary for Him to express His hatred of sin. Adam's final salvation, even in the body, has not yet come. God thrust out the man and the woman, and put cherubim – some kind of angels – to guard the way so that Adam could not get back. A flaming sword turned every way to guard the way. No matter from which direction Adam came he could not get back to paradise.

All of that happened as the result of the fall. Is there any way A note of back? There is one note of hope, in Genesis 3:15, of the entire situation being reversed. The human race will divide into two. Out of the woman will come a 'seed'. From that 'seed' will come a Saviour. He will be born as a human being, as 'the Seed of the woman'. He will strike a fatal blow, and undo all that Satan has done.

 Release from This release from Satan comes in stages. For many centuries Satan in stages God prepares the way. Then there comes one who is not born of a human Father but is the seed of a woman. He lives the life we should have lived. He died as we should have died. He has perfect righteousness, perfect faith. And He makes a perfect way of salvation.

As we believe in Jesus the work of Satan is reversed. If Satan • Jesus reverses Satan's work got us to sin. Jesus gets us to live for God. If the snake engineered the fall, Jesus brings a restoration. If the devil put us out of eternal life Jesus brings us back into eternal life. If Satan's work resulted in our being powerfully driven out of paradise, Jesus' work will bring us back and keep us safe forever. He undoes all that the snake has done, undoing the guilt of sin, the power of sin, eventually wiping out even the very presence of sin.

> By faith in Him we receive eternal life. It is as if we are back in the garden of Eden.
